¿QUÉ SON LOS VERBOS REFLEXIVOS?



A reflexive construction has a reflexive pronoun (see next slide) and a reflexive verb. Reflexive verbs reflect the action back to the subject; the subject of the verb receives the action of said verb.



In the following slides you will see examples of the most used reflexive verbs. You can identify them by the pronoun –se attached to the end of the infinitive. For example: bañarse.

LOS PRONOMBRES REFLEXIVOS Y CONJUGACIONES

To conjugate reflexive verbs, use the subject's reflexive pronoun and its corresponding conjugation.

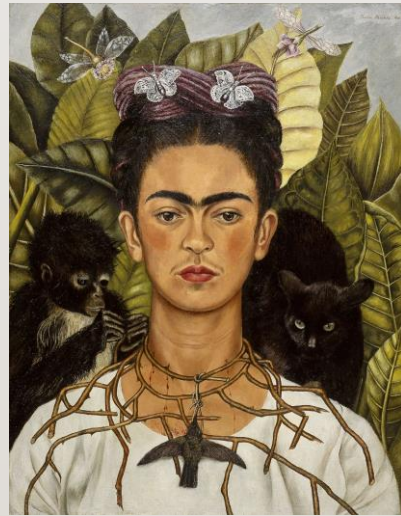
Pronombre	Bañarse	To take a shower
yo	me baño	I take a bath
tú	te bañas	You take a bath
él, ella, usted	se baña	He, she, takes a shower/ You (formal) take a bath
nosotros, nosotras	nos bañamos	We take a bath
Ustedes, ellos, ellas	se bañan	You (plural)/ they take a bath

VERBOS REFLEXIVOS DE LA RUTINA DIARIA

acostarse (ue) <i>to go to bed</i>	lavarse <i>to wash</i>
afeitarse <i>to shave</i>	levantarse <i>to get up</i>
bañarse <i>to take a bath</i>	maquillarse/ pintarse <i>to put on make up</i>
cepillarse los dientes <i>to brush one's teeth</i>	peinarse <i>to comb one's hair</i>
cuidarse <i>to take care of oneself</i>	ponerse <i>to put on</i>
despertarse <i>to wake up</i>	quitarse <i>to take off</i>
dormirse (ue) <i>to fall asleep</i>	secarse <i>to dry off</i>
 ducharse <i>to take a shower</i>	vestirse (i) <i>to get dressed</i>
